<p>Educational supplies that can be used to engage students in learning – these supplies will be used as materials/supplies as an integral part of the lesson plan which leads to student learning outcomes - basically, if these materials/supplies are not available, the lesson couldn't be taught effectively.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Carpets/rugs -Furniture (includes, but is not limited to, tables, desks, chairs, shelves, sofas, lamps, and the likes) -Storage/Storage Bins -Lighting fixtures -Field trip costs -Appliances (microwaves, fridges, coffee makers, toaster ovens, hot plates and warming ovens” unless they meet programmatic/curricular goals) -Tools -Play kitchen sets <p><u>PROHIBITED:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Window coverings (shades/curtains) -Tack boards/white boards (anything that is permanently affixed to walls) -Personal (classroom) printers or ink, unless it is part of programmatic goals (i.e. 3-D printer)
