- First Grandparent's Day effort to do more community-minded events for inclusivity
- BTS (back to school night) briefer than in past, two sessions with teachers can go to one or the other

Allison - Recommends for certain temperatures we do a temporary tent; not a hot ticket item now while temps going down, prepare for spring; suggestion to ask Mary what we can and can't do for shade options.

Allison - Make signing up for specific positions easier; hang QR code sign-up flyers, keep sign-ups displayed.
