Preparing for Pre-K

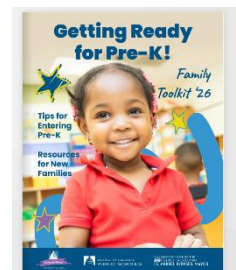
As your child prepares for this exciting transition to school, practicing these skills together will help them feel confident, comfortable, and ready for their new experience:

Please **do not label** the following items (they will be shared by all the students):
